



Anti-Retroviral medication (ARV) for survivors of Sexual Abuse

- Anti-retroviral medication reduces the risk of becoming HIV positive following sexual abuse.
- Anti-retroviral medication must be taken for an uninterrupted period of 28 days.
- Medication must commence within 72 hours of sexual abuse.
- Medication is available to women, men and children of all ages.
- HIV testing is freely available.
- Survivors will receive ongoing counseling.
